Visit Our Monument to the Puerto Rican Flag

Location: One flag at Western and Division and one flag at California and Division



Inaugurated in 1995, the steel flags are welded together to honor the first waves of Puerto Ricans who established themselves in Chicago and the Midwest in the mid 1940s to work for the steel industry. Each flag weighs 45 tons, measures 56' high, and forms a 59' arch from one side of the street to the other. The flags have won numerous awards including the prestigious "Building of the Year Award" by the American Institute of Architecture




