I understand that the submission of this application does not guarantee I will be hired to work at Riot Fest Chicago 2021. I also understand and agree to the terms listed below if I am hired for Riot Fest Chicago 2021.

Riot Fest agrees to provide adequate information and assistance for employees to meet his or her designated requirements.

As a Riot Fest employee, I agree:

- That I will be 18 years of age or older before or on Friday September 9, 2021.
- To adhere to Riot Fest rules and procedures.
- To arrive on time for shifts, complete my duty commitments as scheduled by my supervisor and understand that failure to do so may result in my loss in compensation.
- To behave in a friendly and courteous manner when interacting with the public, supervisors and festival staff.
- To abstain from alcohol and drugs before and during my shift(s).
- To take off my staff shirt when I am not working and will not give my shirt to anyone during the dates of the festival. I will also return my shirt when finished with my shift obligations.
- That I am legally able to work in the United States.
- I will not hold the festival or any of its representatives liable for any loss or damage to my person or injury to my property that may occur during festival activities.
- I understand that if I am found selling or facilitating the sale of illicit substances or am involved with any illegal activity I will immediately be ejected from the festival and lose my right to my compensation. There is absolutely zero tolerance for illegal activity at Riot Fest.
- I understand that any violation of these rules, written or oral, may result in termination of my duties and I may forfeit of my compensation.
